Receive our lovely greetings from Togo, West Africa.

We are so thrilled to tell you about what our Lord is doing here by the means of our ministry. That the LORD has a factory where He turns the saints' prayer investment, money investment and Gospel preaching into saved souls is indeed true. On Sunday October 19, we numbered 10 professions of faith at Davié, our new church. It was the inaugural church services Sunday. In the course of the preceding week, we had three days of fasting and prayer followed by door-door



soul winning and four days of film projection resulting in 22 professions of faith. As a new church, Redeemer Baptist Church needs to grow. Currently, the area is inhabited by only few people. We will keep doing the work of soul winning and

discipleship believing that the Lord will add more saved souls to the church as more and more people join the area. On the second Sunday, we had 11 adults and 30 children. God willing, these kids will be joined by all the orphans we will have in the dorms nearby in about nine months time. Please remember **Redeemer Baptist Church** at Davié in your prayers. The town of Davié is located on the main road to the North at about 20 miles from Lomé, the capital city where we live.

Just on the right side of the Church building, we have the Orphans' dorms in construction. At this time, the work is interrupted because we are running out of financial means. It is a huge challenge for us to complete this dormitory and have the orphans in by August 2015. As you can see, we still have a long way to go. Please be in prayer with us in this path of faith. If the Lord lays on your heart to help financially, don't hesitate to talk with Dr. Steve Williams, our Missions Director. Feel free to send a check to Harvest Baptist Missions in this respect.

In out last Prayer Letter, we told you that Good Shepherd Baptist Church needed about \$3800 for the concrete on their buildings that is to shelter the rest rooms, the pastor's office, and the Children's Sunday School. We thank the Lord – the concrete is done and the kids can't wait to have their Sunday School area completed. To achieve this, we still need about \$2000.

The brethren at **Faith Baptist Temple** have launched their Sunday school classes' construction work. These three classes are also to be used for their Christian school. This is a step of faith with the expectation that the Lord will provide.

Our criterions for self-supporting churches are as follows: a church building, financial self-support, and having a trained pastor in place.
