Dear Steve,

"...do all to the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31b

Greetings Friends! Isaiah 43:7 states, *"Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him."*

Over the past couple of years, this verse has become so precious to me and is core to much of my teaching and preaching. While many struggle with their "purpose in life," the Bible makes it abundantly clear that we were created to glorify God. Certainly, the next logical question becomes, "How do I do that?" The answer to this question is also clearly spelled out in Scripture - to become more like Jesus. Jesus Christ pleased God in all things and was fully submitted to His Father's will. When we endeavor to become more like Jesus, we joyfully fulfill the purpose that God created us for - for His glory! What are you specifically doing to become more like Jesus?

Upcoming Togo, Africa Trip - Fall 2017

We are currently working with HBM Missionary David Laodima to plan a return trip to Togo in the last quarter of this year. There are several primary objectives for this trip:

- to assist with the celebration of the main church in Lome, Savior Baptist Church, as it moves from "mission" status to a "fully indigenous independent church."
- to conduct our second marriage conference. In 2011, we had over 100 couples attend our conference and it was such a huge blessing.
- conduct biblical counseling training among Bro. David's leadership team.

While the final cost of this trip is not yet determined, it is expected to exceed \$5000 as Kris, Abbey, and myself plan to travel to Togo. 


PureMen Ministry
