Receive our greetings in the LORD. We are so thankful to Him for giving us another opportunity in the last two months to do the highest work that is serving Him. We thank you so much for your manifold contribution in this great endeavor.

Justine has been hospitalized a couple of time for her diabetes. She nearly had a stroke on two occasions but the LORD did not allow this to happen. The doctor required that she take two months of complete rest. The boys and I are doing well here as well as Joash in Canada. We appreciate your prayers on our behalf.

The **Redeemer House** kids are doing well. Presently, we have three (3) girls and ten (10) boys. On Sunday September 17<sup>th</sup>, we had them come over Savior Baptist

church to sing and quote Bible verses. They did perform well and the church was blessed. The offering the church made, about \$500



and \$270 of gift from some of you have been of a great help in getting them ready for their schooling. On October 27, Bro Emmanuel, a good brother in Christ from Ohio came with school bags for them. They were so excited about it.

At **Savior Baptist Church**, we baptized 14 new converts in the course of September and had two weddings (one in September and the other in October). On October 4-6, we had early Morning Prayer followed by door-to-door soul winning on Saturday, resulting in 20 professions of faith. The brethren gave testimonies that the morning prayers and the fasting and prayer on Sunday October 29<sup>th</sup> have been a tremendous blessing to them: not only they have been revitalized but also they had some of their prayer requests answered. We expect Dr. Steve Williams, HBM missions' director, his wife Kris and their daughter Abbey in April 2018 on the occasion of the temple dedication and the church autonomy. They will be conducting their second marriage conference here and Bro. Steve will be teaching on some biblical counseling issues. It is our prayer that the Lord provide the necessary funds for their trip.

At **Conqueror Baptist Church**, the brethren devoted three days in October (6-8) to prayer and fasting. A lady and her daughter who made profession of faith on Sunday 8 have being attending the church faithfully since then. We are still

praying that the Lord provide about \$5000 for the church building concrete by January 2018. For family reasons, our co-worker bro. Kossi, in charge of the church will be quitting the ministry. The brethren at **Good Shepherd Baptist Church** had their second wedding on September 10. Many brethren testified that they had their prayers answered as a result of the three consecutive evening prayers in September. On Sunday October 29, they had church services followed by fasting and prayer till 2:30 and then had four new converts baptized. We are still making the cement blocks in view of starting the church building construction in the course of 2018. They are planning on having door-to-door evangelism on Sunday evenings December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> from 4 to 6 p.m.

At **Good News Baptist Church**, the whole day of September 23 was devoted to door-to-door soul-wining. The gospel was presented to 521 persons, resulting into 105 professions of faith. October was saturated with prayers. Bro. Didier said there were many testimonies of answered prayers. Some of the church members who had left came back. On the last Sunday, bro. Ferdinand, one of the deacons surrendered to full time ministry.

**Faith Baptist Temple** had four new converts baptized and seven joined the church. The brethren here are currently making cement blocks for future church construction work. A couple of church members who left the church are vilifying the church. We are praying that the Lord take care of that situation.



In October, **the Redeemer Baptist church**, had its third anniversary. From October 18-22, I conducted a Bible conference on my book, "<u>The Path to Divine's Blessing and Prosperity</u>". From the feedback I got, it was such a blessing to them. On Sunday, we had a special church services followed by a baptism services (7 baptized) and the Lord's Supper. From 4 to 6 p.m., the brethren enjoyed the agape dinner.

We thank God for \$500 we received from Calvary Baptist Church, Shelby, Ohio for the building work. This will be used to pursue the work at **Word of Life Baptist Church**. We still need about \$4500 to have the work done. As soon as the work is done, we will be launching an evangelism campaign and then have an inaugural church services. Pray with us for the Lord's provision.

The brethren at **the Way of Heaven Baptist Church** lost their rented place of worship. We are looking for another place for worship. Please be in prayer with us in this respect. On October 21, three of our co-workers, Bro. Raphael, Bro. Didier, Bro. Kouma and I had the privilege of conducting the ordination services in a local Baptist Church located at about 50 miles from Lomé.

Our county has gone through many protests that turned into violence resulting in injuries and deaths. The current political situation is unpredictable. It can become explosive at any time. We need your prayers.
