Greeting from Togo to each and every one of you! We are deeply thankful to the Lord for your continued support. It is a great privilege for us to labor in the Lord's Great Work with faithful supporters and partners like you.

No news, good news! This is what I would say about our family.

Concerning the ministry, we have much to say; but we can only give a short update on our different areas of the ministry.

At **Savior Baptist Church**, the three days of prayer and fasting that preceded the Passover Sunday was a blessing to the Church. The theme developed in these three days, "*We are His servants*" challenged the brethren to serve the Lord with commitment, love and zeal. The Church made a commitment to help in planting the embryonic churches of Lassa and Ketao.

We still pray for the right man who will be in charge of the **Conqueror Baptist Church**. The sound system the brethren purchased after much prayer and commitment has been unfortunately stolen. They enjoyed this equipment only for about a month. Praise God the thieves could not take away the keyboard. We pray for the Lord's provision to purchase another sound system as soon as possible.

The Temple construction work is finally launched at **Good Shepherd Baptist Church** on March 10, 2019. We praise God for the brethren's enthusiasm, commitment and involvement in the work. The construction somehow slowed down the visitation, soul winning and discipleship activities. Nevertheless, two (2) new converts were baptized on April 28, and two (2) ladies joined the Church. It is our prayer that the construction work be pursued as the Lord's provides. For the mean time the foundation work continues.

Around Passover, they organized three (3) days morning prayer and three (3) days fasting and prayer. On Passover Monday, they had an agape meal fellowship, followed by a soccer game. At the same time, we want to be able to organize a soul winning campaign followed by an inaugural church services at Ketao, **Way of Heaven Baptist Church**.
