We are thrilled to give you an update on what the Lord is doing around here. Our main focus in this praise God that the Church building is covered and the evangelism campaign took place as planned. Our mission team, made up of Bro. Raphael, Bro. myself left Lomé on Tuesday December 3 at 5 a.m. and arrived at Lassa at 1 p.m. We devoted the following day to work around the church compound, located on a rocky hill. From Thursday to Saturday we had fasting and prayer and then went out for door-to-door invitation and soul-watch Christian films we showed. We numbered 41 professions of faith these three nights. On the inaugural Sunday December 8, there were 56 children and 45 adults. On the same day at 5 p.m. our team drove to Ketao to meet a couple of brethren. Since June the brethren here have not been meeting. We agreed with them to resume the church services on Sunday December 15<sup>th</sup>.

Bro. Marc Kabide, our man who will take care of the work at Lassa, is married and father of two (2) children. Be in prayer that these new converts be established in faith.

As for Kétao, we need to construct a shelter in order to launch the evangelism campaign. As we went out for soul-winning, we realized that many people are receptive to the gospel. We pray for the Lord's provision for a shelter in the course of 2020.

We are so thankful to the Lord for bringing into existence a new church at Lassa.
