It is our prayer that this Letter finds each one of you doing well.

We are so thankful to our LORD for his care, protection and provision. We are doing well around here. The Lord has so far kept COVID 19 away from all of us. We held our missionary team meeting on Wednesday August 5, 2020 at Redeemer Baptist Church. It was such a great joy to meet together since this pandemic started. We were so encouraged by the reports we got from each field. We seized the opportunity to spend time together in prayer. We visited the orphanage corn-farm where we a picture.

Up to now, the authorities are not allowing the churches to be reopened. As a test, they allowed a number of churches throughout the country to reopen. Please be in prayer with us: it looks like the government does not want the churches reopening.

Meanwhile, we maintain our Sunday and Wednesday Churches' services via WhatsApp. We mainly do the visitation and discipleship. Sometime such visits or discipleship end up with professions of faith. In the course of July for instance, I got several professions of faith. We also maintain group meeting (not more than 30 persons) in our churches.

We told you in our May Prayer letter that we are also working on assisting our church members who are starving because of pandemic situation. Five hundred dollars we received from a dear lady in States and the contributions from Savior Baptist Church made it possible to rescue over one hundred people. This has been of a great help for these brethren. We are praying for the Lord's provision for the next assistance because the need is still hanging around.



We are currently facing a great deal of demonic attacks at Conqueror BC. In order to deal with that, a team made up of Bro. Raphael, Bro. Fidèle, Bro. Senyo and myself are holding prayer meetings with the brethren of the Church broken up into small groups. So far, the Lord is at work with us. About fifteen children confessed that they are demon possessed. We are also dealing with a couple of possessed adults. It is our prayer that the Lord deliver the Church from these demonic attacks.

We are receiving great amount of feedback about salvation recorded messages on the radio set we are giving out. We pray and hope that many souls be saved by means of these messages. Here is what many said: “after listening to these messages, (1) you know for sure you are saved; (2) you make up your mind to get saved; (3) or you know how to get saved and yet decide not to get saved.”

At Good Shepherd BC a gift by a family made it possible to pursue the Temple construction. Pursuing the construction work fills the mind and prayers of the brethren here. Consequently, the whole Church, notwithstanding this difficult time, devoted a week (from August 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>) to fasting and prayer for the Lord’s provision in this endeavor. Please, be in prayer with them in this respect.
