By His mercy, none of us in all our Missions churches got Covid-19. We can't help saying THANK YOU to all of you, our supporters for your faithfulness, even in this pandemic time.

On March 12th Lemuel turned 18. For those who saw him when he was a baby, you agree with us that it is amazing how fast the time has passed. God willing, he will be graduating from high school this year. Joash on his part, has completed his BA in economics last year.

Because of the progressive reopening of churches set up by the government, Good Shepherd B.C. and Good News B.C. are still not yet reopened. In these two churches, we continue to conduct our Sunday and Wednesday services via WhatsApp. In addition, many house services are held.

Covid-19 has prevented us from launching the evangelism campaign we planned for December 2020 at Ketao in the northern part of the country. We found it wise to direct our outreach to an area within our reach called *Davié Kpetamé* located at about 35 km from Lomé. Currently we hold Bible study class every Sunday with 12 adults and 5 kids. We are prayerfully putting together the construction materials in order to construct a church building before we launch a soul winning and discipleship campaign. We pray and expect that the Lord will bring a church into existence in this area.

At Davié Kpétamé we also started a farm where we rear chicken, goat and sheep. We also cultivate crops such as corn, peanut, cassava and a couple of fruit plants. The farm is mainly to provide for the Redeemer House.
