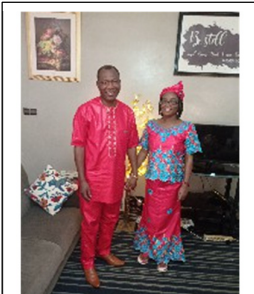

We are so thankful to the Lord for so many things: (1) keeping all of us alive; (2) meeting our daily needs; (3) the souls that have been saved in 2021; (4) providing a man to be in charge of Conqueror Baptist Church. We give thanks and glory to the Lord for two cars we purchased: the first for Bro. Raphael Guegue and his family (in April) and the second for Bro. Fidèle Hamelo and his family (in December). Above all, the Lord amazingly provided for the construction of three School classes at Davié-Kpétamé. The concrete was made on December 19. The total expenses at this level of work is about \$22 900. I cannot actually tell in detail how we got such an amount but I can tell you this is one of my most important experiences in the Lord's answer to prayers. Most of the gifts came from Savior Baptist Church, our Mission based Church (\$14 000).
