We are thankful to the Lord who provided for the building that is currently used for the church services and will also be used for the primary school classes by September.

Quick Summary Update of our Church Planting Work:

1. Savior Baptist Church, Vakpossito, Lomé



Located in the central suburb of Lomé, Savior Baptist Church is our Mission basis. It became autonomous in November 2018. The average attendance in July 2021 is 193 adults and 96 children. We are praying for the church building completion, dedication, numerical and spiritual growth. Many church members moved far away from the Church and having hard time to attend the Church. For the same reason, some of them left the Church.

2. Good News Baptist Church, Adetikope



The church here is located at 21 km from Lomé. It became autonomous on January 1, 2021. Due to the Covid-19, the Church is not yet reopened. Currently, Sunday morning services are held in 19 houses. They have made up their mind to reopen the Church, regardless of the government decision in the coming weeks. It is our prayer that the reopening be done without the government interference.

3. Conqueror Baptist Church, Avinato, Lomé



Located at about 20 km down town Lomé, CBC was officially reopened in November 2020. This area is known for its voodoo worship; the illiteracy rate is very high and poverty very rampant. July average attendance is 91 adults and 98 children.

4. Faith Baptist Temple, Notsé



FBT is located at 90 km from Lomé. This picture shows the level of the construction work. The average attendance in July is 56 adults and 32 children. This church started the primary Christian school since 2018. We would like you to be in prayer for the church construction and the school.

5. Redeemer Baptist Church, Davié



RBC is located at 30 km from Lomé. The attendance on Sunday August 8 is 44 adults and 28 children. Please, pray for the church growth and the construction work.

6. Hope Baptist Church, Dapaong



Started in February 2017, HBC is located in the upper north at 526 km from Lomé. The average attendance in July is 28 adults and 27 children. Please, be in prayer for bro. Elisée and his wife: they got married in Avril 2021.

7. Word of Life Baptist Church, Kara



Located at about 450 km from Lomé, WLBC came effectively into existence in December 2019. Three months later, Covid-19 showed up and brought the church activities to the standstill. This had a negative impact on the church growth. The average attendance in July is 13 adults and 22 children.

8. Way of Life Baptist Church, Kétau



We effectively started this church three months ago. Due to Covid-19, we couldn't organize any evangelism campaign. So far, we had no inaugural services. It is located in the north at about 492 km. There is an urgent need to construct a place of worship. The average attendance in July is 16 adults and 21 children.

9. Rock Baptist Church, Davié-Kpétamé



Starting this church is but a divine appointment. We just followed the Lord's direction in going out soul winning. Surprisingly, a couple of people responded to the gospel. The average attendance in July is 30 adults and 11 children. We are also planning on starting a Christian school here. For the meantime, we are constructing a building for the church services that will be used later for the school. Please, pray for the Lord's provision.

Please, do remember the Redeemer House kids (5 girls and 9 boys, from 7-17 years old). They will be very soon resuming the school. This is the peak time in terms of expenses.
