Dear Pastor and Brethren,

July 2025

Warm greetings from Togo to you all in our Lord Jesus' name! To start with, I would like you to thank the Lord with my family and me, for "The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad." Firstly, our three boys were all successful at school during this school year. Secondly, the Lord made it possible for us to start the children club at Kpala, the place where we believe He is leading us to start a new church. The first meeting on May 25, 2025, we counted 43 children. They were taught Bible verses and songs and had cookies and juice at the end.

In the afternoon of June 1 after our children's class, our car could not start because it was broken. The coming of the electrician late at night to repair the car made it possible for us to come back home at 10: 15 pm. We are thankful to the Lord who brought us home safely. Please, be in prayer with us for our car as we take this bumpy road every week to share the Gospel with nonbelievers in this area.

In May we started discipleship with four persons who made professions of faith. In the course of May-June, we distributed 30 gospel tracts, presented the gospel to 9 unbelievers and there were 2 professions of faith.

During our door-to-door soul wining, we met Rosaline, a lady living at Kpala, who used to go to church. She said: "Please, come and start the church near me so that I can go to church. I feel something missing inside me when I don't go to church". Our earnest prayer here is to be able to purchase the land for the church that costs \$45,000 (2 plots) in this area. Would you mind joining us in prayer for land purchasing at Kpala?

I plan to be in the USA from August through October 2025 for deputation. Last year when I was there, the Lord made it possible for me to visit twelve churches. Seven among them took our family on for support. This year, the visa restrictions and travel bans affect Togo.
